Masonic CHIP's "Purple Packet" Be proactive. Be prepared.

In the event that your child should ever become missing or separated from you, the Masonic CHIP "Purple Packet" gives law enforcement and recovery officials essential materials to help find your child. All identifying materials generated during a Masonic CHIP event are given to the child's family. The program is free of charge to participating parents, as a result of generous public and private donations.

What does the "Purple Packet" include?

- **A digital still photo and digital video interview** - children are asked a series of questions to provide information in front of a height chart backdrop. The CHIP interview captures the appearance, speech, mannerisms, and other important personal characteristics of a child. It can be quickly distributed via the media to reach a huge audience and assist in the quick recovery of an abducted child. (The picture and video are recorded onto a 3" mini-CD, compatible with the Pennsylvania Amber Alert System, and given to parent or guardian). It is the cornerstone of CHIP.
- **Fingerprints** - Children's fingerprints are taken using a non-toxic ink. Fingerprint cards are given to parent or guardian.
- **DNA** - A DNA kit is provided to parent or guardian to be completed at home. The DNA kit includes envelopes for 1. hair samples, 2. nail clippings, and 3. oral swab for saliva sample.
